We are trying to refocus on academics for the next two weeks and then celebrate during the last two days before break.</p> <p>Mr. Billy is allowing the two room coordinators to attend if there is a classroom party before break if the teacher would like. Since he's been allowing parents in for meet and greets and teaching family traditions, he felt it was acceptable to allow room coordinators in the classroom to host the party. Anyone who comes into the classroom must be vaccinated and if not vaccinated, must get tested within 24 hours and show the negative COVID test to Mr. Billy prior to entering the classroom.</p> <p>New Jersey has gone into red zone for number of COVID cases</p> <p>Please send children into school with at least one well fitting mask</p> <p>The school does not have a way to keep kids 6 feet apart at lunch. He is hopeful to keep cases down. So far transmission in the building has not happened.</p> <p>The school will be having a lockdown drill in the coming weeks. The school is required to do a fire drill and lockdown or evacuation drill monthly so there will be a lockdown drill happening in the next two weeks.</p> <p>Mr. Billy will now start locking the vestibule so if anyone needs to get into the school after it begins, please use the buzzer on the outside of the building on the right side.</p>
